Start of the school day in September

Just a reminder about the start of each school day. Parents of children in Year 1 can walk them to the playground but please leave them at the door for them to find their own way to class, and deal with their own coats and bags. Perhaps parents of current Reception children could start doing this now, ready for September. There will be staff in the cloakroom to assist if children need help. Please can only parents of children in Reception from September enter the rear doors to take their children to the class.

If parents need to speak to a teacher, please ask at reception where staff will willingly pass on messages or find a teacher if required.

Uniform

Please remember uniform is available from Nationwide Uniform in Spilsby. All children need a PE kit in school all week.

SATs

Year 6 and Year 2 SATs will take place in May. Both of these are statutory assessments and children need to be in school on the dates set by the government, to complete the tests. Please do not book any appointments or holidays during this time. Actual dates can be provided in September if required. Year 6 is an important year for pupils. Please consider this before booking any holidays. Not only do SATs take place, there are taster days for their new schools and visits from their new teachers.

School Meals (UIFSM)

In September the children who are in Y2 now, will stop being entitled to a free school meal when they move into Y3. Please remember you will need to logon to The Farm Kitchen to order and pay for school

meals from September. The Government is continuing the scheme of free meals for all children in Reception, Y1 and Y2
