Sports Funding 2017-2018

At Mareham Le Fen CE Primary School we place a high value on providing a full and varied PE curriculum at our school. The school aims to use the Governments Sports Funding to ensure all children are able to participate in a range of sports, engage in healthy lifestyles, improve the provision we teach and introduce sports which they would not otherwise experience.

We provide a range of after schools sports clubs varying them so that all children over the course of the academic year have an equal opportunity.

The Governors monitor the impact of all spending.

Sports funding is made up of a standard allocation of £8,000 per primary schools and an additional £5 per child. This is expected to continue until 2018/2019. 2017-2018 most schools will receive an extra £8000.
